## *the* REVELATION EARTH'S FINAL YEARS

**THE DAYS OF LOOKING** at the book of Revelation as esoteric, with hard-to-understand symbolism, has taken a back seat in our present age as we witness the events of this book unfold in our present age. This makes the Revelation the most important and essential book for our present age

The Revelation reveals the rise of a powerful leader who strives to control the world through military might and economic mandates. It was given so you would know and understand what will happen in the world, why it is happening, and the final glorious outcome that will take place for God's people.

### UNDERSTANDING THE REVELATION

One of the roadblocks to understanding the book of Revelation is not understanding that it is organized in chronological order. When the book is read as you would any other book, allowing the transitions to do their work of progressing from one idea to the next, much of the mystery of the ordering of last day events is removed. The revelation is filled with such transitional words and

phrases as "hereafter," "after this," "one woe is past; and there come two woes more hereafter," "the last plague," and many more. With this in mind, let's look at this esoteric book whose mysteries have been unlocked in our present age.

### THE WIDE VIEW

The Apostle John was told to write down the revelation into three categories: "Write the things which you have seen, and the things which are, and the things which shall be hereafter."<sup>1</sup> In this wide view, the revelation is broken down into three parts:

1. *Things Seen*. These are the things which John saw in Revelation 1.
2. *Things Which Are*. These concern the condition of the church present in John's time as well as the church throughout history and in our present age. The *things which are* is the apostasy/deception of the church outlined in Revelation 2 and 3. This apostasy, taking place before the Antichrist appears, is also confirmed by the Apostle Paul in 2 Thessalonians 2:1-3. If we believe we are living in the last days (most do), then we must also acknowledge that the majority claiming to be Christian are not (most don't).

3. *Things Future.* The events that are yet future take place after the church is in apostasy and the one called the Antichrist comes to power to lead the world through it's final seven years. These events are outlined in Revelation 4-22. It is these events that are the focus of this months newsletter.

This ordering reveals that currently the church is in great deception, thinking they are Christian when they are not. Because of how great the deception is, we know that the Antichrist's arrival is soon to take place, and we will soon enter earth's final seven years.

Let's move on to....

## THE THINGS WHICH ARE SOON COMING, AS OUTLINED IN REVELATION 4-22

The things which are soon coming are also ordered under three categories: the seven seals, seven trumpets, and seven vials. What is significant about this ordering is that the seals do not appear until they are opened by Christ. The trumpets do not blow until the last seal is opened. The vials are not poured out until the last trumpet has blown. This means the events outlined with the seals cannot take place after the trumpets or before the vials. Neither can the events outlined with the trumpets take place before the seals or after the vials. And so it is with the pouring out of the vials, which cannot take place until after the seals are opened and the trumpets have blown. Since the Antichrist has not yet appeared, we also know the seals have not yet opened; neither has the trumpets blown or the vials been poured out.

## SEVEN SEALS

Scripture is clear that the seals are opened by Christ in heaven.<sup>2</sup> As we will find throughout the book of Revelation, nothing takes place on earth under its own volition. Nothing happens on earth until it is first set in motion in heaven.

When Christ opens the first seal, this permits the one called the Antichrist to appear and to put in motion earth's final events that lead to earth's final seven years

and the destruction he brings with the opening of seals 2-6. Here's what is released under these seven seals:

*Seal 1:* The Antichrist is released<sup>3</sup>

*Seal 2:* Peace is taken from the earth, war and violence is everywhere<sup>4</sup>

*Seal 3:* There will be famines, hyperinflation, and the middle class will be eliminated<sup>5</sup>

*Seal 4:* The result of opening seals 1-3 is the death of one fourth of the world's population.<sup>6</sup>

*Seal 5:* The multitudes killed with the opening of seals 1-4 are now in heaven with the majority being Christian and Jews.<sup>7</sup>

*Seal 6:* A global earthquake takes place moving the mountains and islands from their longitude and latitude position. The sun becomes black, the moon looks like blood, comets and asteroids hit the earth.<sup>8</sup> These disturbances are recognized by those on the earth to announce the wrath and judgment of Christ, not the wrath of the Antichrist (great tribulation) or the wrath of God (7 vials), but the wrath of Christ.<sup>9</sup>

*Seal 7:* Before the seventh seal is opened, we are shown what takes place in heaven to prepare for the opening of the seventh seal. Here is what is taking place:

*Four Winds* of destruction are held back by the four angels responsible for holding back the events of the seventh seal until the 144,000 Jews are sealed.<sup>10</sup> The four winds represent the judgement released throughout the earth in all directions: North, South, East, and West.

*144,000 Jews are Sealed* to protect them from the destruction that will be released when the seventh seal is opened.<sup>11</sup>

*The Great Multitude* of Christians who died during the Great Tribulation by the Antichrist are now in heaven.<sup>12</sup>

## SEVEN TRUMPETS

Now that the 144,000 Jews are sealed and protected from the trumpet judgments, the seventh seal is ready to

be opened. Revelation eight reveal that the following events take place to prepare for the blowing of the seven trumpets:

*Silence In Heaven* after the seventh seal is open.<sup>13</sup> During this silence the following take place:

*Seven Angels* are given seven trumpets.<sup>14</sup>

*An Eighth Angel* is given incense to offer with prayer for all God's people.<sup>15</sup>

*After the Prayers*, the seven angels blow their trumpets in answer to the prayers.<sup>16</sup>

*Trumpet 1*: One third of trees and all green grass are burnt up.<sup>17</sup>

*Trumpet 2*: One third of the sea (salt water) become blood.<sup>18</sup>

*Trumpet 3*: One third of rivers and streams (fresh water) contaminated and unfit to drink.<sup>19</sup>

*Trumpet 4*: One third of the sun, moon, stars are darkened.<sup>20</sup>

The last three trumpets are called woes, indicating that the disasters released from these trumpets are much worse than the disasters released with trumpets 1,2,3,4.<sup>21</sup>

*Trumpet 5*: An angel is given the key to open the bottomless pit to release locusts resembling scorpions to torment those without God's seal for five months.<sup>22</sup>

*Trumpet 6*: Four fallen angels are released from the Euphrates River to motivate 200 million soldiers from the Far East to kill one third of earth's population.<sup>23</sup> Earth's population is now reduced by half when added to the one fourth already killed in Revelation 6.

In Revelation 10 John is shown that before the angel blows the seventh trumpet, an angel, described as a "mighty angel," has a "little book open," which is this revelation.<sup>24</sup> Now that the revelation is being fulfilled, this mighty angel declares that "there should be time no longer."<sup>25</sup> It is the earth and our material existence that

keeps track of time. The sun, moon, and stars were created for this purpose<sup>26</sup>

Now that the end of all things has come, the Apostle John is told to "eat the little book."<sup>27</sup> In other words, he was told to read and understand the revelation given to him. At first, he took pleasure in what he read. After digests the reality of what was going to happen, the Apostle is disturbed and becomes sick at the horrors he sees coming. The angel then tells him to warn all nations and peoples—rich and poor—about what is coming. We are to do the same.<sup>28</sup> Understanding the horrors to come we are also compelled to warn others.<sup>29</sup>

Revelation 11 continues to describe events taking place before the seventh trumpet sounds. The main thrust of this chapter concerns the appearing of the two witnesses. These two witnesses are the Jews and Church who survived the holocaust/great tribulation unleashed by the Antichrist and are now fully revived and empowered by the Holy Spirit.<sup>30</sup> They are now able to do miraculous exploits in the same way that Moses and Elijah released God's judgments in their day. Even as God worked through Moses and Elijah, He works through the Church and Jews releasing His judgements. In this way God's people reclaim for God the nations the Devil has under his control. This revival of God's people is the last event to take place when the sixth trumpet is blown.<sup>31</sup> After their three and a half year witness, a great earthquake will destroy one tenth of the city of Jerusalem killing over seven thousand people causing those left in Israel to be afraid and give glory to God.<sup>32</sup> This is when the majority of Jews will accept Jesus as their Messiah.

After the Jews repent, the seventh angel blows the seventh trumpet. As the nations are returned to Christ the twenty-four elders fall on their faces and worship God.<sup>33</sup> However, on earth the nations are angry as they recognize that Christ's wrath/ judgment has come.<sup>34</sup> The true temple is now opened in heaven in preparation for God's people to enter.<sup>35</sup>

These events end the events taking place before the seventh angel releases the events of the seventh trumpet.

## FURTHER DETAILS FOR UNDERSTANDING WHY THE TRUMPETS ARE BLOWN

Before God's seven vial judgments are poured out upon the earth, we are given understanding of why the events in Revelation 8-11 took place as they did.

Revelation 12 reveals a great conflict between the Devil and Israel, here represented as a "great red dragon" with seven heads, ten horns, and ten crowns, and "a woman clothed with the sun."<sup>36</sup> This conflict between the Devil and God began when Lucifer, who became the Devil, determined to usurp God's position and to sit on His throne as God.<sup>37</sup> The conflict became more intense when Christ was sent to destroy the Devil's influence. He motivated one third of the angels in heaven to come to the earth to destroy Christ "as soon as he was born."<sup>38</sup> Since he cannot physically harm anyone on earth, the Devil inspired Herod to do the work for him by killing all children two years and younger.<sup>39</sup> His plan did not work. Christ was born and fulfilled the work God sent him to do.<sup>40</sup> The Devil becomes angrier and motivates the religious leaders to crucify Christ. Later he motivates the Romans to destroy Jerusalem and the Temple causing the Jews to flee into the "wilderness" of the Gentile nations where she finds God's protection.<sup>41</sup> In our present age the Devil will inspire the Antichrist and the world's leaders to persecute and kill God's people.

The Jews continued to live in Gentile nations until it was time for her to return to Jerusalem at the end of the "times of the Gentiles."<sup>42</sup> This took place when Israel regained her statehood in 1948 and Jerusalem was reclaimed as her capital in 1967. During this time war took place in heaven with Michael and his angels and the Devil and his angels. The Devil loses the battle and is cast out of heaven and *into* the earth.<sup>43</sup> That the Devil and his angels were cast *into* the earth is significant as it lets us know where they are today. My article, [Where Are the Fallen Angels Today?](#) reveals where they are.

The Devil is cast into the earth at the start of earth's final generation when salvation, the kingdom of God, and God's judgements are going to be completed.<sup>44</sup> Now in the earth he pours out his great tribulation on God's people because he knows he has very little time left.<sup>45</sup> He first goes after Israel because she gave birth to Christ, but is not able to harm her because of God's protection during this three and a half year holocaust.<sup>46</sup> This protection infuriates the Devil even more. He then goes throughout the earth to kill any Jew not protected in Israel by God and any Christian belonging to God.<sup>47</sup>

In Revelation 13 it is revealed how the Devil is able to accomplish his task of killing one half of the world's population.<sup>48</sup> In versus 1-10 the beast described here is the realignment of all nations under ten global regions, also described in Daniel 2:33-34, 41-42. Through this global empire, which today is described as the New World Order and the Great Reset, the Devil will have access to all people, enabling him to make war with God's people and overcome them wherever they are on earth. This realignment is already in place and outlined in the United Nations *The Millennium Development Goals Report 2009*. The *Regional Groupings Map* in the report shows the breakdown of nations in each region. For more information, see my newsletter, [Toward 2030 and A New World Order](#). It is the Devil's man, the one called the Antichrist, who is given leadership over this New World Order.

In Revelation 13:11-18 it is revealed that the Devil is able to accomplish his task of killing one half of the world's population using the two largest and most influential religions in the world: Catholicism and Islam. These will encourage and cause the majority to submit to the New World Order which is currently being set in place. Already we've heard the pope encouraging a global economy, global governance, and the *Great Reset*. Eventually the leaders of these two religions will perform miracles as the means to deceive the majority to submit to the New World Order and its cashless economy. ## PREPARATIONS FOR THE SEVEN VIALS

Up to this point seven years have gone by: three and a half years of great tribulation released by the Antichrist (7 Seals) and three and a half years of Christ's wrath released with the blowing of the trumpets (7 Trumpets). With Revelation 14 we now come to the end of our present age as God releases His seven vial judgments. Before the angels pour out their vials, we are taken back into heaven to see the preparations being made for the vials to be released.

What we see are the 144,000 Jews of Revelation 7. Here they are in heaven having been martyred by the Antichrist and are revealed as the "first fruits" to be received by God.<sup>49</sup> In the Old Testament, the first fruits of the grain offering were offered before the Hebrews could harvest the rest of their crop.<sup>50</sup> It is the same with these 144,000 Jews. After God receives them, then the rest of God's people can be received.<sup>51</sup>

Before God's wrath is poured out through the seven vials, His mercy is poured out one last time as He sends an angel to fly through the air to preach "the everlasting gospel" to encourage those left on earth to "Fear God and give glory to Him; for the hour of His judgment is come: and worship Him that made heaven, and earth, and the sea, and the fountains of waters." Note that it is God's "hour" (sixty minutes) of judgment that will be poured out. A second angel follows the first explaining why those left need to heed the warning of the first angel. A third angel follows the second explaining who will experience God's wrath and the terribleness of this wrath.<sup>52</sup>

Because of all the horrors that have been and will be released upon the earth, patience is the key necessary for God's people to get through it all. We will be here when the seven seals are opened and the seven trumpets have blown, but will escape the seven vials of God's wrath. By the time you get to this point you are certain to have little strength left and be tempted to give up. The encouragement here is, it won't be long. Hold on just a little while longer.<sup>53</sup>

After the third angel declares his warning Christ returns on a white cloud. He sends his angels to reap the harvest of His people.<sup>54</sup> This is the rapture. It takes place before God's wrath is poured out upon the earth, but after the seven seals and seven trumpets have been released.

After God's people are removed from the earth, God sends another angel to cast those left on the earth into God's great wrath.<sup>55</sup>

This wrath of God is revealed in Revelation 15 to be the seven vials, which are the last judgments the earth will experience, and comes out of the seventh and last trumpet.<sup>56</sup>

Standing with the seven angels waiting to pour out God's final judgment are all those martyred by the Antichrist. Knowing what is about to take place, those in heaven praise God for His works and judgments, now realizing with full understanding how just and true God's ways are. We may not understand a lot of why things happen as they do, but the day is coming when full knowledge and understanding will be given to us.<sup>57</sup>

## SEVEN VIALS

In Revelation 16 the seven vials are released in less than sixty minutes. Keep in mind that God's people do not experience these vials of God's wrath; they were removed before God's wrath.

*Vial 1:* Horrible, malignant sores appear on those with the mark of the beast and who worship his image<sup>58</sup>

*Vial 2:* All salt water become as blood. Everything in the waters dies<sup>59</sup>

*Vial 3:* All fresh water become as blood and is undrinkable<sup>60</sup>

*Vial 4:* The sun becomes so hot that the people on earth are scorched<sup>61</sup>

*Vial 5:* The sun no longer produces light. Without the sun, the orderly gravitational effect it has on the planets, stars, comets, etc. is removed and cause them to move erratically through the solar system, even hitting the

earth. Without the sun, there would be no protective magnetic field, allowing extreme radiation and particles from our solar system to enter in. And then there would be the extreme drop in temperature. No wonder “the people remaining on earth gnawed their tongues because of the pain and sores.”<sup>62</sup>

*Vial 6:* Instead of repenting of their sins, the hatred of those left on the earth toward God increases even more. The Euphrates River dries up to permit the kings of the Far East to cross. Demons are released to gather all the armies of the earth to gather to the “battle of that great day of God Almighty” at the place called Armageddon. They did not come to war against each other, but to turn their weapons on the God who caused all their pain.<sup>63</sup> The actual battle is described in Revelation 19.

*Vial 7:* When the seventh angel pours out his vial, God responds to the global military coming against Him by declaring, “It is done.” It is over. He sends thunders, lightnings, and an earthquake so great it divides the earth into three parts so that all the cities of every nation collapses. Every island and every mountain also disappear and hail weighing as much as one hundred pounds fall on those on the earth. Yet, instead of repenting, they prefer to blaspheme and reject God.<sup>64</sup>

Also coming out of the seventh vial, and before the battle at Armageddon takes place, Revelation 17-18 reveals why the vials were poured out upon the earth.<sup>65</sup>

The earth here is described as “that great city, Babylon.” We know Babylon in this revelation is the earth for the following reasons:

1. From Revelation 1-13 there is no mention of Babylon when all the destruction is taking place upon the earth. Then in Revelation 14:8 Babylon is mentioned for the first time as “having fallen.” The only thing that has fallen and come under judgment up to this point has been the earth.
2. Babylon is referred to in Revelation 16:19-20 as “the great city,” yet it describes how in this “city” all the cities of all nations collapsed, and every island and every mountain throughout the earth disappeared. What city has ever encompassed

all the cities and nations of the earth? None. Only the earth has this distinction.

The judgement on Babylon/Earth is revealed in Revelation 17 and 18. This judgement is released because of the earth’s influence over the people to focus on and love the things belonging to the earth and not God. Everything we see and hear and can touch belongs to the earth and is to be used, but not to take the place of trusting God. As God’s people we are to come out of the earth by being in the earth but not of it.<sup>66</sup> The pleasures, riches, and life the world offers should not be what motivates us, in where we find our pleasure, or cause us to worry, even when we don’t have the necessities to sustain our earthly existence.<sup>67</sup> We are to relate to all the earth offers with temperance.<sup>68</sup> When we separate from the things belonging to this world, we will not be part of the judgment that is coming and will be removed/raptured before God’s great hour of wrath is poured out through these vial judgments.

In light of our current pandemic, one of the reasons for the final judgement and end to our current earthly system is revealed in Revelation 18:23 as being because the people with the big money (merchants) have deceived the majority to trust the world’s system of health and pharmaceutical drugs (sorceries/pharmakeia) and not God. A deceived person does not know they are deceived and think what they believe and are doing is okay in God’s eyes, when it is not. It’s good to remember that Eve was deceived because she moved away from God’s clear command to not eat of the tree of good and evil. She began to reason that the tree was pleasant to look at, was good for food, and would even make her wise.<sup>69</sup> God explained what the consequence would be: they would die physically.<sup>70</sup> Concerning Revelation 18:23 God is clear that participating in pharmaceutical drugs deceives you and the consequence for doing so leads to eternal death. Even as Eve was

deceived into believing her actions were good, we also can be deceived by looking at the stated benefits while rejecting God's command. Pharmakia/pharmaceuticals are a deception to be avoided.

## THE BATTLE AT ARMAGEDDON

Preparations for the battle at Armageddon began when the militaries of all the nations gathered to make war with Christ himself in Revelation 16:14-16. Before the actual battle took place, we were given understanding in Revelation 17 and 18 why this battle was taking place. Here in Revelation 19 and 20 the battle is engaged.

There is much rejoicing and celebration in heaven as those in heaven realize that the Devil's influence over the earth will now end and the eternal marriage, unity of God and His people will now take place.<sup>71</sup>

To solemnize this marriage, Christ appears at Armageddon ready for battle riding upon a white horse with his armies from heaven following close behind, also on white horses.<sup>72</sup> Christ's weapon of choice is a sword, the word of God, by which he defeats the nations.<sup>73</sup> The battle is short, and the dead are eaten by the birds enjoying Christ's marriage supper.<sup>74</sup>

## ONE THOUSAND YEAR RULE WITH CHRIST

After this final battle at Armageddon, the Devil is chained in the bottomless pit for one thousand years.<sup>75</sup> Without the Devil's influence, sin no longer rules. For one thousand years there is peace, and righteousness rules with Christ as earth's king. Those who rule with him are those martyred by the Antichrist. We know that only those killed by the Antichrist rules during this time because the rest of the dead are not raised from the dead until this thousand years is complete.<sup>76</sup>

One thousand years is plenty of time to remodel and repopulate the earth and develop cities and nations. We saw this take place after the flood when Noah and his family of eight started from scratch to rebuild cities and nations. In less than 600 years many cities were built and Babylon, the first major empire after the flood, was fully

developed. Though we may not understand it now, it appears that the people who inhabit, raise families, and develop nations during this one thousand years are those who were martyred by the Antichrist.

After the one thousand years is complete, the Devil is released from the bottomless pit. Immediately he exerts his will to deceive the people and again gathers the nations militaries to come against God's people. He is again defeated by fire from heaven. The Devil is now cast into the lake of fire where he will never be released, and his influence will never be known on the earth again.<sup>77</sup>

After the Devil's final defeat, the final judgement of all the dead—saint and sinner—takes place. Whoever did not have their name written in the book of life were cast into the eternal lake of fire.<sup>78</sup> God's people receive the rewards of eternal life in God's kingdom and ruling as kings with Him over all He created.

## A NEW HEAVEN AND NEW EARTH

God's eternal plan for creating man now enters its fulfillment. All God's people enter eternal life where there will be a new heaven and a new earth. This will not be a rebuilt or repaired earth as it was during the previous one thousand years, but a completely new earth with the old heaven and earth no longer in existence.<sup>79</sup> 2 Peter 3:10 informs us the old heaven and earth disappears "with a great noise, and the elements shall melt with fervent heat, the earth also and the works that are therein shall be burned up."

In this new heaven and earth, God lives with man face-to-face. There will be no more influence of sin; no more sorrow, crying, pain, or death. God's people will inherit all things with Christ as God's children. Those who do not belong to God will burn eternally in the lake of fire.<sup>80</sup>

In this new heaven and earth will be God's pride and joy, the new heavenly Jerusalem. It is this New Jerusalem that is the bride of Christ. Those who live here will be those whose names were written in the book of life. The only ones who could have their names in this book were those from earth and of the human species.<sup>81</sup> We were created to be kings and priests and joint heirs with Jesus

to rule with him over all God created.<sup>82</sup> No angel or other creature has this privilege.

In this new Jerusalem will be God's throne and a river of water of life coming out from it. The tree of life will be on both sides of this river producing twelve fruits for food and leaves for healing. The curse of sin will also be removed. We will see God face-to-face with His name forever in our foreheads. There will be no night or sun because God's glory will shine brighter than the sun.<sup>83</sup>

Because of the glorious hope of eternal life that will be ours, let us keep the same focus the Apostle Paul had: "For I reckon that the sufferings of this present time are not worthy to be compared with the glory which shall be revealed in us."<sup>84</sup>

## SIX ENCOURAGEMENTS

The revelation ends in Chapter 22 with six encouragements:

1. Christ will come quickly, and you will be blessed if you keep what is written in this revelation.<sup>85</sup>
2. Continue in your righteousness and faith in God—don't let go!<sup>86</sup>
3. Christ will come quickly and bring your eternal rewards with him. Hold on! It won't be long.<sup>87</sup>
4. Continue to obey the word of God, the commandments of God, and the teachings of Jesus.<sup>88</sup>

5. If you do not have the Holy Spirit actively living in you—repent and put your trust in Jesus today.<sup>89</sup>
6. Do not add to the words of this revelation and do not remove any words from this revelation.<sup>90</sup>

## FINAL THOUGHT

As the revelation continues to unfold, God's people have the responsibility to hold on no matter what they may go through and to teach others why things are happening, what is coming, and to repent and live in the Spirit of God.

The Revelation is not given so we could ponder and wonder what it means. It is given so we would understand and be prepared for what is coming.

The Revelation is the only book in the Bible that offers a clear blessing to those who read, hear, and keep it: "Blessed is he that reads, and they that hear the words of this prophecy, and keep those things which are written therein: for the time is at hand."<sup>91</sup> You are encouraged to read and understand this revelation and then tell others what is coming and to prepare.
