



Revelation 13 And The Global Cashless Economy

Revelation 13:16-17 reveals a chilling prophecy: when the Antichrist ascends to power, he will mandate a global cashless economic system. Anyone who does not comply will be put to death. This system will become the sole means of conducting any economic transaction. Whether you're rich or poor, without this system, you will be unable to purchase food, visit a doctor, acquire medicine, pay rent, renew your driver's license, or carry out any form of transaction. The implications are horrific, but this is the direction we are headed with a fully cashless society.

The term "mandate" in these verses suggests that the framework for this cashless economy will already be established before the Antichrist takes control. He will merely mandate that all comply to the cashless economic system that is currently being put in place.

Up until the COVID-19 pandemic in 2020, we were gradually moving toward a global cashless economy. However, since the onset of COVID, this transition has accelerated dramatically, transforming from a slow train to a turbo-charged jet. The pandemic has accelerated the establishment of the infrastructure necessary for an operable cashless economy. The United Nations Agenda 2030's goal is to have it all in place no later than 2030. So far we are on track for reaching this goal.

With President Trump's ambitious announcement to make the United States the "crypto capital of the planet" and the development of a national crypto reserve, all signs point to the readiness for nations to complete this shift from physical transactions to digital ones. As the United States advances with this initiative, I expect it to trigger a domino effect, with most nations following suit and emulating the U.S. lead.

The national storage of cryptocurrency will mark the final step before nations fully transition away from physical transactions. I anticipate that from 2025 through 2028, most nations, if not all, will be positioned to completely eliminate physical money, with many currently working toward this goal. At this time Sweden, the United Kingdom, China, and Norway are in the process of completing their transition.
